201 Basics of Organizational GHG Accounting Students with an interest in GHG management, in particular, those interested in becoming GHG inventory managers, corporate environmental and sustainability managers, investors and auditors. For example, a client says he wants his company to be "carbon neutral" and you are asked to help them understand their carbon footprint.

<u>202 Basics of Project-Level GHG Accounting</u> Students with an interest in GHG management, in particular, those interested in becoming GHG project developers.

211 GHG Information Management Systems Students with an interest in GHG management, in particular, those interested in gaining employment in corporate environmental and sustainability departments.

<u>501 IPCC Guidelines: Introduction and Cross-Cutting Issues</u> This course is designed for students interested in developing or working with regional or national level greenhouse gas estimation and inventories.
