#### Courses

**301 GHG Accounting for Forest Inventories** Students with an interest with an interest in forest carbon accounting. Coursework is applicable for corporate environment and sustainability managers, investors, and auditors working with organizations that own forested land or engage in activities affecting forested lands.

<u>321 GHG Accounting for Energy Efficiency Projects</u> Students with a background in energy efficiency interested in understanding how energy efficiency and GHG accounting can be integrated to develop offset projects.

**331 GHG Accounting for Renewable Energy Projects** Students interested in understanding how to account for GHG emissions in the renewable energy sector, with a focus on hydropower and wind energy projects.

**501 IPCC Guidelines: Introduction and Cross-Cutting Issues** This course is designed for students interested in developing or working with regional or national-level greenhouse gas estimation and inventories.

#### Diplomas

<u>GHG Accounting</u> Teaches the fundamentals of carbon accounting with reference to a range of GHG programs and frameworks. The diploma offers a rigorous foundation on the principles of GHG accounting.

<u>Carbon Management</u> Offers students the opportunity to develop both an understanding of GHG accounting frameworks and the analytical tools available to assess emission mitigation opportunities.

<u>GHG Measurement, Reporting & Verification</u> Provides an intensive background on emissions accounting and auditing methods. This diploma prepares students with the skills and knowledge to prepare and audit GHG inventories and projects for international standards and programs.
